Transportation

Bradley International Airport, near Hartford, is about a 45 minute ride from the conference center. If you will be driving, directions can be found on the Incarnation Center web site. Alternatively, a van will be available for you to share with others, to and from the airport, at various times during the day. The cost will be \$40 round trip. Please pay that fee as you register. We will send you the van schedule after you register and when we know flight arrivals and departure times. Also keep checking www.gemn.org.

Lodging

Accommodations at Incarnation are mostly twin bed rooms with women's/men's bathrooms down the hall. So think modest, bathrobe and flipflops when packing. Early bird registrants may try for a private room - first come, first served. Private rooms are very limited.
